## **URBAN LEADERSHIP FELLOWS (ULF) PROGRAM**

#### **MISSION**

Since 1992, the Youth Education Fund Committee of The Municipal Forum of New York has sponsored the Urban Leadership Fellows (ULF) Program with the mission to introduce talented young men and women to the municipal securities industry and inspire them to pursue careers in the field.

The ULF Program, managed by Futures and Options, is a paid summer internship program for graduating seniors from New York City high schools who have expressed interest in careers in finance.

#### **IMPACT**

- 687 students have completed internships through the ULF Program.
- \$737,250 in college scholarships have been awarded to ULF alumni.

#### 2017 STATISTICS


- 47 interns at 41 private and public sector entities
- 100% high school graduation rate
- 100% college matriculation
- 25 high schools → 34 colleges

#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

- Internship Interns work 40 hours per week and attend events organized by Futures and Options, including orientations, an opening breakfast, municipal bond school, Excel workshops, public speaking, writing, and presentation trainings, a trip to DC hosted by the MSRB, and a closing luncheon.
- Scholarships The Municipal Forum awards each ULF student a \$500 book grant at the closing luncheon. College alumni who meet GPA requirements receive a \$1,000 or \$1,250 annual scholarship. Alumni of the ULF program are also eligible for two application-based scholarships: a \$2,000 community service award and a \$2,500 Carey Gabay excellence award.
- Internship Partners A variety of firms host ULF interns, including law firms, financial advisory firms, investment banks, rating agencies, and municipal entities.
- Funding The Municipal Forum supports the ULF Program through funds raised from its Annual Awards Dinner.

#### **STUDENTS**

- Students are college-bound, graduating seniors with an interest in finance, law, and/or government.
- ULF interns represent minority, multicultural and underserved populations.
